AN ACT relating to Members of the Federal Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia.

[Assented to, 5th December, 1900.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows (that is to say):—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1900, and shall be read and construed as one with the Con- struction. stitution Act, 1889, and its amendments.

Constitution Act—Amendment.

Members of Western Australian Parliament to vacate seats on sitting in Federal Parliament. 3. WHEN any Member of either House of the Parliament of Western Australia is elected a Member of either House of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia, he shall vacate his seat in the Parliament of Western Australia on taking his seat in the Parliament of the Commonwealth.
