AN ACT to confirm certain Expenditure for the year ending 30th June, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.

[Assented to, 9th October, 1899.]

Preamble.

HEREAS it is necessary that Legislative authority be obtained for certain expenditure incurred for the services of the year 1897-8, not included in any Appropriation Act for the year: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-----

1. THE expenditure of the sum of Three hundred and ninetynine thousand two hundred and four pounds fifteen shillings and Excesses on Votes on the Consolidated eightpence, set forth in the Schedule A to this Act, shall be and the Revenue Fund for same is hereby confirmed and allowed, and is hereby declared to be the year 1897-8. a charge against the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

2. THE expenditure of the sum of Three hundred and thirty-six thousand six hundred and forty-three pounds and fourpence, set forth in Schedule B to this Act, shall be and the same is hereby confirmed Fund for the year and allowed, and is hereby declared to be a charge against the General Loan Fund of the Colony.
