AN ACT to amend the Bush Fires 1885.

[Assented to, 28th October, 1898.]

HEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Law relating to Bush Fires: Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as the Bush Fires Short Title. Act, 1885, Amendment Act, 1898.

- 2. SECTION seven of the Bush Fires Act, 1885, is hereby Amendment of Sec. 7 amended by omitting all the words after the word "pounds" in the of 49 Vict., No. 9. fifth line thereof.
- SECTIONS eight and nine of the Bush Fires Act, 1885, are Repeal of Secs. 8 and 9 of 49 Viet., No. 9. hereby repealed.
