AN ACT to amend the Medical Act. 1894.

[Assented to, 11th September, 1895.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as "The Medical Act Amendment Act, 1895," and shall be read and construed together with "The struction. Medical Act, 1894."

2. PARAGRAPH Ten of the Second Schedule of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the words "or Colonial University," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "or legally consti-Schedule of principal tuted and recognised Australian, Tasmanian, or New Zealand Act. University."

3. PARAGRAPH Thirteen of the said Second Schedule is hereby repealed.
