AN ACT to extend the provisions of the Sharks Bay Pearl Shell Fishery Act, 1892, to other places.

[Assented to, 23rd December, 1897.]

E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THE Governor may, by proclamation published in the Government Gazette, extend to any other portions of the coasts of Provisions of the Colony, or of the adjacent islands, so much of the provisions Sharks Bay Pearl of the Sharks Bay Pearl Shell Fishery Act, 1892, as he may deem Shell Fishery Act, 1892, may be exfit; and the provisions of the said Act so extended shall thereupon tended by proclamaapply as fully to such portions of the coasts aforesaid named in such proclamation as if the same were included in and defined by such Act.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
