AN ACT to amend "The Loan Act. 1894."

[Assented to, 2nd October, 1895.]

THEREAS it is desirable to extend the Southern Cross-Coolgardie Railway as far as the Township of Kalgoorlie: Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. IN the Schedule to "The Loan Act, 1894," the second item, "Railway from Southern Cross to Coolgardie Goldfields (exclusive extension of Railway from Stock), £228,000," shall be held to include the extension from Coolgardie to of the line to Kalgoorlie.

2. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Loan Act, Short Title. 1894, Amendment Act, 1895."

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
