AN ACT to confirm certain Expenditure for the year ending 30th June, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.

[Assented to, 11th December, 1897.]

HEREAS it is necessary that Legislative authority be obtained for certain expenditure incurred for the services of the year 1895-6 not included in any Appropriation Act for the year: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

The expenditure of the sum of Four hundred and ninetythree thousand three hundred and seventy-eight pounds nine Excesses on Votes of the Consolidated shillings and fourpence set forth in the Schedule A to this Act, shall Revenue Fund for be and the same is hereby confirmed and allowed, and is hereby the year 1895-6 declared to be a charge against the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

The expenditure of the sum of Eighty-four thousand eight Excesses on Votes of hundred and sixty-six pounds one shilling and tenpence set forth in the Loan Accounts the Schedule B to this Act, shall be and the same is hereby confirmed for the year 1895-6. and allowed, and is hereby declared to be a charge against the Loan Accounts of the Colony.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
