#### ANNO QUINQUAGESIMO QUARTO VICTORIÆ REGIN

#### No. X.

AN ACT to confirm certain Expenditure for the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine.

[Assented to, 26th February, 1891.]

THEREAS it is necessary that Legislative authority be obtained for certain expenditure incurred for the services of the year Preamble. 1889, not included in any Appropriation Act for the year: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

The expenditure of the sum of Six thousand four hundred and sixty-five pounds twelve shillings and eight pence, set forth in Excesses on Votes the Start Handred Excesses on Votes for the year 1889. the Schedule to this Act, shall be and the same is hereby confirmed and allowed, and is hereby declared to be a charge against the General Revenues of the Colony.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act. W. C. F. ROBINSON, Governor.
