AN ACT to increase the Duty payable on Unmanufactured Tobacco.

[Assented to, 26th February, 1891.]

HEREAS we, Your Majesty's dutiful and loyal subjects, the Preamble Members of the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in Parliament assembled, have towards raising the necessary supplies to defray the expenses of the Public Service freely and voluntarily resolved to give and grant to Your Majesty the Duty hereinafter mentioned; And whereas it is expedient to increase the duty payable on Unmanufactured Tobacco; Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. FROM and after the passing of this Act, in lieu of the duty Duty increased of One shilling per pound payable on unmanufactured tobacco under the provisions of "The Tariff Act, 1888," there shall be charged, raised, collected, and levied on unmanufactured tobacco a duty of Two shillings per pound.

- 2. THE said increased duty shall be collected and levied as prescribed by "The Tariff Act, 1888," in respect of the duties therein mentioned.
- Short Title.
- 3. THIS Act may be cited as "The Tobacco (unmanufactured) Duty Act, 1891."
