# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

No. I.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of certain Additional and Unforeseen Expenses in the year One thousand eight hundred and eightyeight, over and above the Estimates for that year.

[ Assented to, 12th November, 1888.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THAT out of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall and may be issued and applied Further appropriation of £16,659 3s. to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year 1d. for the year 1888. ending the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, and not provided for in the Appropriation Act for that year, a sum not exceeding Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty-nine Pounds Three Shillings and One Penny, the said amount being appropriated as set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

#### Appropriation—Supplementary for 1888.

Treasurer to pay on Governor's warrant.

2. THE Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay such sum or sums of money for the purposes aforesaid, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf specified in the Schedule, as the Governor from time to time shall by warrant under his hand direct.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
