# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

No. I.

AN ACT to give the Commissioner of Railways power to appoint and dismiss certain classes of Railway Servants.

[ Assented to, 22nd July, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies by and with the advice and Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1. THAT this Act may be cited as "The Railway Servants Short title. Act, 1887."
- 2. THAT the Commissioner of Railways shall have the power commissioner of appointing, of fining, and of dismissing, whether summarily or Railways to have otherwise, any person falling within any class of railway servants in power to dismiss certain persons. the Schedule to this Act mentioned.

3. THAT all such appointments, fines, and dismissals be Approval of the subject to the approval of the Governor.

Fines to be paid to Railway Servants' Benefit Society. 4. THAT any fines levied and paid under the provisions of this Act shall not become and form part of the General Revenue of the Colony, but shall be paid to the Railway Servants' Benefit Society.
