# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

No. I.

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of certain additional and unforeseen Expenses in the year One thousand eight hundred and eightyfive, over and above the Estimates for that year.

Assented to, 11th September, 1885.

THEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Preamble. Revenue of the Colony the several sums hereinafter mentioned to provide for the payment of certain additional and unforeseen expenses for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and eightyfive, over and above the Estimates for the same: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

THAT out of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall and may be issued and applied Further appropriate to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year 8d for the year 1885. ending the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred

and eighty-five, and not provided for in the Appropriation Act for that year, a sum not exceeding Twenty-five thousand and eighty-six pounds thirteen shillings and eightpence, the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely:—
