#### No. XVI.

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of certain additional and unforeseen Expenses in the year One thousand eight hundred and eightysix, over and above the Estimates for that year.

[ Assented to, 16th August, 1886.]

THEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Revenue of the Colony the several sums hereinafter mentioned to provide for the payment of certain additional and unforeseen expenses for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and eightysix, over and above the Estimates for the same: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THAT out of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there shall and may be issued and applied ation of £74.935 3s. to defray the supplementary charge for the service of the year 11d. for the year 1886. ending the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred

and eighty-six, and not provided for in the Appropriation Act for that year, a sum not exceeding Seventy-four thousand nine hundred and thirty-five pounds three shillings and eleven pence, the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely:—
