AN ACT to appropriate the sum of One Hundred and Fifty-three Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty-five Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Eightpence out of the General Revenue of the Colony for the Service of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven.

[Assented to, 13th September, 1876.]

HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have Preamble. authorized to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue the several sums hereinafter mentioned for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven; Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, and by the authority of the same, as follows :----

1 OUT of the General Public Revenue not otherwise by law Appropriation of the specially appropriated there shall or may be issued and applied, for Revenue for 1877.

the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventyseven, any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of One Hundred and Fifty-three Thousand, Two Hundred and Twenty-five Pounds, Eighteen Shillings, and Eightpence, for defraying the charge of the Colonial Government for the year ending the Thirty-first day of December, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-seven; the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely:----
