No. XIV.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of Four Thousand and Twenty-five Pounds Two Shillings and Sixpence, in addition to the sum of One Hundred and Seventy-six Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty-six Pounds Four Shillings and Eightpence, out of the General Revenue of the Colony for the Service of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty.

[Assented to, 8th September, 1880.]

HEREAS by an Act passed in the 43rd year of the reign of Preamble. Her present Majesty, No. 27, the sum of One Hundred and Seventy-six Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty-six Pounds Four Shillings and Eightpence was voted for the service of the present year. And whereas the sum of Four Thousand and Twenty-five Pounds Two Shillings and Sixpence, in addition to such last-mentioned sum, is required to be expended: Be it enacted by His Excel-

lency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:---

Four Thousand and Twenty-five Pounds Two Shillings and Sixpence for the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty.

1 OUT of the General Public Revenue not otherwise by law Further appropriation of specially appropriated there shall and may be issued and applied, for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty, any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of Four Thousand and Twenty-five Pounds Two Shillings and Sixpence for further defraying the charges of the Colonial Government for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and eighty, the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely:--
