AN ACT to appropriate the sum of One Hundred and Eighty-six Thousand Two Hundred and Four Pounds and Eightpence out of the General Revenue of the Colony for such Services as shall come in course of payment during the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three.

Assented to, 23rd September, 1882.

HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorized to be issued and applied out of the General Preamble. Public Revenue the several sums hereinafter mentioned, for such ervices as shall come in course of payment during the year One housand eight hundred and eighty-three: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Depenlencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Jouncil thereof, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
