AN ACT to provide for the Payment of certain additional and unforeseen Expenses in the year One thousand eight hundred and eightytwo, over and above the Estimates for that year.

[Assented to, 24th August, 1882.]

HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have Preamble. authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Revenue of the Colony the several sums hereinafter mentioned to provide for the payment of certain additional and unforeseen expenses for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and eightytwo, over and above the Estimates for the same: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:----

1.
