AN ACT to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, beyond the grants for that year.

Assented to, 13th August, 1883.

HEREAS by an Act of the Legislative Council, made and Preamble. passed in the forty-fifth year of the reign of Her Present Majesty, No. 13 of 1881, the sum of One hundred and fifty-eight thousand nine hundred and eleven pounds four shillings and sevenpence was granted and applied for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two; And whereas by a further Appropriation Act of the said Legislative Council, made and passed in the forty-sixth year of the reign of Her Present Majesty, No. 4 of 1882, the further sum of Eleven thousand six hundred and fifty-eight pounds eleven shillings and tenpence was also granted and applied for the services of the said year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two; And whereas there have been expended for the services of the said year, in excess of the several grants made for the several services, the sums in the
