AN ACT to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, beyond the grants for that year.

[Assented to, 15th August, 1884.]

HEREAS by an Act of the Legislative Council, made and passed in the forty-sixth year of the reign of Her Present Preamble. Majesty, No. 23 of 1882, the sum of One hundred and eighty-six thousand two hundred and four pounds and eightpence was granted and applied for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three; And whereas by a further Appropriation Act of the said Legislative Council, made and passed in the forty-seventh year of the reign of Her Present Majesty, No. 5 of 1883, the further sum of Twenty-four thousand three hundred and twenty-two pounds nine shillings and fourpence was also granted and applied for the services of the said year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three; And whereas there have been expended for the services of the said year, in excess of the several grants made for the several services, the sums in the account hereunto annexed, that is to say, in all the sum of Two

thousand and fifty-nine pounds three shillings and eightpence: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:----

THE sum issued and applied for the services of the year ended the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, beyond the grants obtained for the same year, that is to say, the sum of Two thousand and fifty-nine pounds three shillings and eightpence, be and the same is hereby confirmed and allowed, and is hereby declared to be a charge against the general Revenues of the Colony.
