AN ACT to amend "The Branding Consolidation Ordinance, 1864."

[Assented to, 19th September, 1879.]

HEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Branding Consolidation Ordinance, 1864," by extending the facilities for hunting for and collecting stray stock: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 THE words "being unenclosed," contained in the seventh Modification of seventh secsection of the said Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
