An Act to Regulate the Punishment of Whipping. [Assented to 27th August, 1884.

HEREAS it is expedient to regulate the punishment of Whipping: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as 'The Regulation of Whipping Act, short title 1884.
- 2. Whenever any person shall be sentenced by any Court or Justice Instrument and or other legal authority to be whipped, the number of strokes and the number of strokes and the instrument with which they shall be inflicted shall be specified in the cified in sentence sentence.

3. Every such sentence of whipping, except in the case of a person whipping to be under the age of fourteen years summarily convicted, shall be inflicted inflicted in prison in some gaol or prison, and no person who is not officially connected with the said gaol or prison shall be present at the infliction of the punishment.

4. Every such sentence of whipping in the case of a person under Boys under confidence to a consisted shall be inflicted fourteen to the age of fourteen years, summarily convicted, shall be inflicted privately.

5. The punishment of whipping for prison offences shall not be inflicted on a prisoner in the presence of any other prisoner.
