### No. XI.

AN ACT to repeal certain Ordinances relative to Slaughter-houses.

[Assented to, 12th September, 1876.]

HEREAS an Ordinance was passed in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, numbered seven, intituled "An Ordinance to repeal an Act, passed the sixth year of Her 16 v. 7. present Majesty, No. 1, entitled "An Act to regulate the Slaughtering of Cattle and other Stock in Towns" and to enact other provisions in lieu thereof; and also an Ordinance was passed in the same year, numbered ten, intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the establish- 16 V. 10. ment of public slaughter-houses and to regulate the slaughtering of stock therein; and also an Ordinance was passed in the same year, numbered twelve, intituled "An Ordinance to amend the public Slaughter-house Ordinance, 1852;" and whereas it is expedient to repeal the said Ordinances; and also to empower the Governor to resume any place heretofore established as a public slaughter-house

under the provisions of the said recited Ordinance, 16th Victoria, No. 10; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Repeal of certain Ordinances.

1 THE said recited Ordinances shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Governor may resume any public slaughter-house.

2 THE Governor is hereby empowered, by notice to that effect in the Government Gazette, to resume on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen any place heretofore established as a public slaughter-house under the provisions of the first section of the said recited Ordinance, 16th Victoria, No. 10; and thereupon, on publication of the said notice, the right of any person to slaughter beasts in any such slaughter-house or otherwise to use the same shall absolutely cease and determine.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
