AN ACT further to amend "The Wild Cattle Nuisance Act, 1871."

[Assented to, 8th September, 1883.]

HEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Wild Cattle Nuisance Act, 1871": Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. THE 2nd Section of the said Act is amended by striking out the words "annual licensing meeting" in the third line, and inserting the words "quarterly licensing meetings" in lieu thereof; and the 12th Section of the said Act is hereby repealed.

2. THAT in each district the Licensing Bench of Magistrates shall meet on the first Monday in the months of December, March, June, and September, for the purpose of granting licenses under this Act.

**3.** THIS Act may be cited as "The Wild Cattle Nuisance Act, 1871, Amendment Act, 1883."

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
