An Act to amend 'The Waste Lands Unlawful Occupation Act, 1872.' [Assented to 3rd July, 1878.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend 'The Waste Lands Unlawful Occupation Act, 1872': Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

## Unauthorised Occupation of Crown Lands—Amendment

Amendment of sec. 1 of 36 Vic., No. 8 1. Section 1 of the said Act shall be, and the same is hereby amended, by omitting the words 'except sandalwood' in line nine of the same.

Cutting or removing wood, to be deemed an unlawful occupation of Waste Lands

2. From and after the passing of this Act, any person who shall saw or split any wood on the Waste Lands of the Crown, or remove any wood from off the Waste Lands of the Crown, without lawful authority to do so, shall be deemed to be in the unlawful and unauthorised use and occupation of the Waste Lands of the Crown within he meaning of the said Act.
