AN ACT to amend "The Elementary Education Act, 1871."

[Assented to, 17th July, 1874].

HEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Elementary Preamble. Education Act, 1871," with reference to the support of Government Schools and the limitation of Grants to Assisted Schools; Be it enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 A SUM not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three pounds Increase of support to ten shillings per head, on children attending schools as mentioned in Government Schools. the twentieth section of the said Act, shall be allotted to Government Schools, instead of the sum of Two pounds fifteen shillings per head.

## Elementary Education—Amendment.

Increase of maximum sum payable as a grant to Assisted Schools. THE sum of One pound fifteen shillings per head shall be the maximum of the grant-in-aid mentioned as One pound seven shillings and sixpence in sub-section 3 of the twenty-sixth section of the said Act.

Repeal of portion of s. 19 of 35 V. 14, regarding fixed salaries.

3 THAT the following words in section 19 of "The Elementary Education Act, 1871," be and are hereby repealed: "but all teachers now in receipt of fixed salaries shall not be disturbed in the enjoyment thereof, while employed in such schools."

Teacher's claim for retiring allowance not to be affected.

THE teacher of any school who may have been in receipt of a fixed salary, and whose emoluments may be subsequently paid from results, shall not forfeit any claim he may have for a retiring allowance.
