AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of Ninety-three Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-eight Pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony for the service of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.

[15th July, 1867.]

"HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue the several sums hereinafter mentioned for the service of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, and by authority of the same, as follows :----

1 OUT of the General Public Revenue not otherwise by Law Appropriation of Revenue specially appropriated, there shall or may be issued and applied for for 1868. the service of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of Ninety-three Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-eight Pounds for defraying the charge of

the Colonial Government for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, the said amount being appropriated as follows:—
