AN ORDINANCE to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, beyond the grant for that year.

7th August, 1868. 7

THEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council made Preamble. and passed in the Thirtieth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, No. 8 of 1866, the sum of Eighty two thousand and fortyfive pounds was granted and applied for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven: And whereas there has been expended for the services of the said year in excess of the grants made for the several services in the account hereunto annexed, the sum of Twelve thousand seven hundred and thirty-one pounds, seventeen shillings, and ninepence; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency The Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

THE sums issued and applied for the services of the year ended the Excess of Expenditure for thirty-first day of December One thousand eight hundred and sixty- 1867, confirmed. seven, beyond the grant obtained for the same year, that is to say, the sum of Twelve thousand seven hundred and thirty-one pounds, seventeen shillings, and ninepence, be and the same is hereby confirmed and allowed, and is hereby declared to be a charge against the general Revenues of the Colony.
