AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of One Hundred and One Thousand Two Hundred and Ninety Four Pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony, for the Service of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy.

[12th July, 1869.]

HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have Preamble. authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue, the several sums hereinafter mentioned, for the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 OUT of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by Law Appropriation of the specially appropriated, there shall or may be issued and applied for Revenue for 1870. the service of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy,
