AN ACT to confirm the Expenditure for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy, beyond the grant for that year.

[Assented to, 4th August, 1871.]

THEREAS by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council made and passed in the Thirty-third year of the reign of Her Preamble. present Majesty, No. 12 of 1869, the sum of One hundred and one thousand two hundred and ninety-four pounds was granted and applied for the services of the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy: and whereas there has been expended for the services of the said year, in excess of the several grants made for the several services in the account hereunto annexed, the sum of Fifteen thousand four hundred and ninety-six pounds fifteen shillings and eleven pence: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of the Colony of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

THE sums issued and applied for the services of the year ended the thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and seventy, beyond the grant obtained for the same year, that is to say, the sum of Fifteen thousand four hundred and ninety-six pounds, fifteen
