AN ACT to enable the Governor to extend "The Fremantle Carriage Ordinance, 1868," to other Towns.

[2nd January, 1871.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 IT shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time, by proclamation published in the *Government Gazette*, to extend the provisions of the Ordinance No. 6, of 1868, intituled *An Ordinance*

for licensing Carriages in the Town of Fremantle," to any other Town or Towns; and thereupon the said Ordinance shall be read and applied for all purposes, as if the name of the Town or Towns to which it shall be so extended from time to time had been inserted therein in addition to the name of the said Town of Fremantle.
