An Ordinance to appropriate and apply the sum of Seventy Thousand One Hundred and Forty Pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony for the Service of the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Four. [15th July, 1863.]

HEREAS the Governor and Legislative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue, the several sums hereinafter mentioned for the service of the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Four: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council aforesaid, and by the authority of the same:-

1. THAT out of the General Public Revenue not otherwise by Appropriation Law specially appropriated, there shall or may be issued and applied Revenue for 1864. for the Service of the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Four, any Sum or Sums not exceeding the Sum of Seventy Thousand
