AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of Eighty Two Thousand and Forty Fire pounds out of the General Revenue of the Colony, for the Service of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty seren.

> [ 9th July, 1866.]

WHEREAS the Govenor and Legishative Council have authorised to be issued and applied out of the General Public Revenue, the several sums hereinafter mentioned for the service of the year, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven: Be it therefore enacted, by Eis Excellency the Govemor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative C'ouncil thereof, and by authority of the same, as follows:-

1 OUT of the General Public Revenue, not otherwise by Law specially appropriated, there shall or may be issued and applied for the service of the year One thousand eight hunclred and sixty-seven, any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of Eighty Two Thousand and
