AN ORDINANCE to amend the Ordinances relating to Trespasses by live stock.

[ 9th July, 1866. ]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

**1** THE words “nor less than Five Pounds” at the conclusion of the second section of the Ordinance passed in the twenty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty, No. 8, of 1860, are hereby repealed.

Penalty for persons in unauthorized occupation of Crown lands not exceeding £100.
