AN ORDINANCE to amend the Ordinances relating to Trespasses by live stock.

[9th July, 1866.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:---

1 THE words " nor less than Five Pounds" at the conclusion of the Penalty for persons in second section of the Ordinance passed in the twenty-fourth year of the Crown lands not exceeding reign of Her Majesty, No. 8, of 1860, are hereby repealed.
