AN ORDINANCE to rectify a Clerical error in the Ordinance entituled "An Ordinance to amend the Colonial " Passengers Ordinance 1861."

[11th July, 1864.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1. THE First section of the Ordinance of the Legislative Council The word "before" in the Twenty seventh of Victoria No. 9 of 1863, shall be read and No. 9 to be read "after." applied as if the word "after" had been inserted therein instead of
