AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Insolvent Ordinance, 1863."

[11th July, 1864.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Preamble.

1. THE Third section of the Ordinance of the Legislative Countries of 27th cil Twenty-seventh of Victoria, No. 20 of 1863, shall be read and mended. applied as if the words "the Court shall make an order granting such Certificate" had been inserted therein after the word "acquitted" at the end of the second line thereof, and the word "if" had been

inserted in the said section between the word "case" and the word "there" in the third line of the said section.
