An Ordinance to amend 'An Ordinance for vesting the Ordnance Lands and Buildings in the Principal Secretary of State for the War Department.'

[Assented to 9th June, 1862.

E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:—That in the fourth section of the Ordinance of the Legislative Council, twenty-fifth of Victoria, No. 2 of 1861, the words 'the Governor' shall be erased, and the words 'the officer commanding the troops' substituted therefor; and in the sixth section thereof the words 'or the Commanding Royal Engineer for the time being in the said Colony' shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
