An Ordinance to vest in Her Majesty a certain Piece of Ground forming a Portion of a Public Thoroughfare, known by the Name of Pier Street, in the City of Perth.

[Assented to 14th October, 1858.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the boundaries of a certain portion of land in the City of Perth known as the Government demesne, in order to afford sufficient standing room for a new Government House about to be erected thereon, and for that purpose to include within the said boundaries a part of a public thoroughfare in the said city known in the official records as Pier-street: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that from and after the passing hereof all right of property which may have at any time been vested by Ordinance or otherwise in the Trustees of the Town or City of Perth, in any part of the area more particularly described in the Schedule hereunto annexed, shall absolutely cease and determine, and that the whole of the said area, and all the right and title in law and in equity thereto, shall be and the same are hereby re-vested in Her Majesty, her heirs and successors, for the public uses of the Colony aforesaid.
