An ORDINANCE to enable the Governor to borrow Seven Thousand Pounds and to apply the same towards the erection of a new Government House.

THEREAS it is expedient to erect a new Government House, Preamble. and for that purpose to borrow and take up at interest a sum of money not exceeding Seven Thousand Pounds; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Depenlencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:-

I. THAT it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of Governor empowered to the Executive Council from time to time, and at any time or times, and for such period or periods as he may deem proper, to borrow at interest, after such rate or rates as he and they shall consider right, from any one or more person or persons, company or companies, in or out of the said colony, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole Seven Thousand Pounds, and to apply the said sum or sums of money, so borrowed as aforesaid, in and towards the erection and completion of a new Government House in the city of Perth.

II. THAT the said sum or sums of money, so borrowed as afore- Monies secured to Lenders said, together with interest thereon as aforesaid, shall be secured to the by Debentures. lender or lenders thereof, by one or more Government Debenture, or Government Debentures, according to the form hereunto annexed signed by the Governor, and countersigned by the Colonial Secretary, for the

Principal and Interest secured on the Colonial Revenue. time being, which the Governor is hereby empowered to issue, and shall be and are hereby charged upon and made payable out of the public revenues of the said colony; and such sum or sums of money, so borrowed as aforesaid, shall and may be made payable, and be paid, at such time or times as shall be specified for that purpose in the Debenture or Debentures applicable thereto, and the interest accruing due in the mean time shall be paid out of the said revenue by half yearly gales on every thirtieth day of June and thirty-first day of December in each year.

Debentures transferrable.

III. That it shall be lawful for the person or persons, company or companies so lending money upon such Debentures, or any future holder or holders thereof legally entitled thereto, to transfer the same by endorsement thereon to any other person or persons, company or companies whatever and such Transferree or Transferrees shall thenceforth stand in all respects whatsoever on the same footing as the original holder or holders both as to principal and interest.
