## **An Ordinance to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen Expenses in the Year One Thousand Eight hundred and Fifty-six.**

**W**HEREAS it is necessary to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen expenses in the Year One thousand Eight hundred and Fifty-six, for which no provision has been made;—Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:—

I. THAT out of the product of the Revenue of the said Colony, there shall and may be issued and applied a sum not exceeding Five thousand and Fifty-eight Pounds, Ten shillings, in the manner following, that is to say:—

For the Expenditure of the Penal Establishment at Rottneſt Island, a ſum not exceeding Three hundred Pounds.

For Pensions and Gratuities, a ſum not exceeding Twenty-five Pounds.

For Eccleſiaſtical ſervices, excluſive of Eſtabliſhments, a ſum not exceeding Thirty-five Pounds.

For Rent, a ſum not exceeding Fifty-two Pounds, Ten ſhillings.

For Works and Buildings, a ſum not exceeding One thouſand Five hundred Pounds.

For Harbour Maſter, excluſive of Eſtabliſhments, a ſum not exceeding Two hundred and Fifty Pounds.

For Rottneſt Penal Eſtabliſhment, excluſive of Eſtabliſhments, a ſum not exceeding One thouſand Pounds.

For payment of Interest and of Debts and Debentures, a ſum not exceeding One thouſand Eight hundred and ninety-ſix Pounds.

II. THAT the Colonial Treasurer ſhall iſſue and pay, from time to time, any ſum or ſums of money, for the purpoſe hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the ſums reſpectively in that behalf hereinbefore ſpecified, to ſuch perſons and in ſuch portions as the Governor ſhall, by an order or orders in writing, ſigned by him, from time to time direct; and the ſaid Treasurer ſhall in his accounts be allowed credit for all ſums ſo paid by him in purſuance of ſuch orders accordingly; and the receipts of the perſons to whom ſuch ſums ſhall have been ſo paid reſpectively, ſhall be to the ſaid Treasurer a full diſcharge for the ſum or ſums of money for which the ſaid receipts ſhall have been reſpectively given, and the amount thereof ſhall be paſſed to his credit in account accordingly.
