### ANNO DECIMO NONO VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

## No. XVI.

An Ordinance to repeal an Ordinance passed in the 17th year of the reign of Her present Majesty, No, 14, imposing Duties on imported Goods, and to make other provisions in lieu thereof.

WHEREAS it is expedient to modify the existing duties payable on Goods imported into Western Australia, and to provide for certain exemptions from the Customs Duties;—Be it Preamble. therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:—

I. THAT an Ordinance passed in the 17th year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Ordinance to repeal an Ordinance No. 14, nance passed in the 12th year of the reign of Her present Majesty, pealed;

No. 8, imposing duties on imported Goods, and to make other provisions in lieu thereof," shall be and the same is hereby repealed, Except as to Goods already imported into the said colony and already imported and warehoused therein, subject to the payment of Customs duties; worehoused.

upon which said goods the duties leviable under the said recited Ordinance shall be paid and levied, if the same be paid on or before the first day of August next.

Such goods, if no II. THAT upon all imported Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, duties have been paid save as aforesaid, enumerated in the first schedule hereunto anbefore the passing hereof—pay accordinate nexed, and upon which no customs duties shall have been paid before the passing of this Ordinance, there shall be levied and paid the duties respectively specified in the said schedule.

Collection of duties III. THAT the duties specified in the said first schedule in first schedule. shall be collected and levied in the manner provided by any Ordinance or Ordinances for the time being in force for the general regulation of the Customs of the said colony.

Schedule 2—duty free list.

IV. THAT the goods, wares, and articles enumerated in the second schedule hereunto annexed, shall and may, from and after the passing of this Ordinance, be imported into the said colony free of duty.

V. THAT it shall be lawful for the Governor of the said Governor may give colony, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, upon special exemption at any special application made to him for that purpose, to exempt from the payment of duty any particular goods or article which, under the special circumstances of the case, shall be deemed to merit such exemption.
