**An Ordinance to provide for the payment
of certain unforeseen expenses during the
Year 1852.**

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the payment of ^{Preamble.}
certain unforeseen expenses for the present year 1852, for
which no provision has been made; Be it therefore enacted, by His
Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies,

by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out of the Revenue of the said colony there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the additional supplementary charge for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1852, and not already provided for, a sum not exceeding £6,202 11s. 9d., in the manner following; that is to say:—

£6,202 11s. 9d. voted for Supplementary charge for 1852.

For the Civil Establishment, a sum not exceeding £252 5s. 7d.

For Pensions' Allowances, and Gratuities, a sum not exceeding £20.

For Ecclesiastical Services, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £465.

For Charitable Allowances, a sum not exceeding £90.

For Police and Gaols, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £230

For conveyance of Mails, a sum not exceeding £80.

For Works and Buildings, a sum not exceeding £2,547 19s. 11d.

For Miscellaneous Services, a sum not exceeding £2,524 6s. 3d.

As more particularly set forth and detailed under each head of expenditure respectively in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

Colonial Treasurer—Governor's orders to the extent of £6,202 11s. 9d.

II. AND be it enacted, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay, from time to time, any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions, as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing, signed by him, from time to time direct, and the said Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.
