

WESTERN AUSTRALIA. ANNO DECIMO SEXTO VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

No. XXI.

An Ordinance to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen Expenses during the year 1853, and also for the appropriation of the Revenue for the year 1854.

HEREAS it is necessary to provide for the payment of certain Preamble. unforeseen Expenses of the Year 1853, for which no provision has been made; and also for the Service of the Year 1854;—Be

it therefore enacted, by his Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof—

THAT out of the produce of the Revenue of the said colony. there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the Supplementary charge for the Year ending on the 31st December, 1853, and not already provided for, a sum not exceeding £9,630 1s 3d., as detailed in the annexed Schedule, No. 1.

II. AND be it enacted, that a sum not exceeding £31,091 17s. 1d., be charged upon the Revenue of the said Colony for the Service of the year 1854, and applied in the manner following; that is to

Civil Establishment.

For the expenditure of the Civil Establishment, a sum not exceeding £15,801 17s. ld.

Revenue,

For Revenue Services, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £170.

Administration Justice.

For Administration of Justice, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £370.

Ecclesiastical.

For Ecclesiastical Services, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £350.

Charitable allowances

For Charitable Allowances, a sum not exceeding £250.

Education.

For Education, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding

Hospitals.

For Hospitals, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding

Police. Gaols. Rent.

For Police, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £450. For Gaols, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £1560.

For Rent, a sum not exceeding £105.

Transport. Conveyance of mails.

For Transport, a sum not exceeding £170. For Conveyance of Mails, a sum not exceeding £1100. For Works and Buildings, a sum not exceeding £3750.

Works and buildings. Roads, streets, and

For Roads, Streets, and Bridges, a sum not exceeding £2800.

For Miscellaneous Services, a sum not exceeding £170.

Miscellaneous vices.

For Immigration, a sum not exceeding £290.

Immigration. Surveyor General. For Surveyor General, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £270.

Aborigines.

For Aborigines, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding

Harbour master.

For Harbour Master, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding £850.

For Repayment of Debts, a sum not exceeding £1000. Debts.
For Incidental Expences, a sum not exceeding £50. IncidentalIn manner more particularly set forth and detailed under each head of Expenditure respectively in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and marked No. 2.

III. THAT the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay, from Treasurer may pay time to time, any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor shall, by any order or orders in writing signed by him, from time to time, direct; and the said Treasurer shall and be allowed credit in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums so paid by him in purfor same in his acsuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to counts. whom such sums shall have been so paid respectively, shall be to the said Treasurer a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

IV. That the said Schedules shall be taken to be, and be, part Schedule to form part of this Ordinance.
