An Ordinance to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen Expenses during the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-three.

HEREAS it is necessary to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen Expenses of the present Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-three, for which no provision has been

made; Be it therefore enacted, by his Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof—

- I. THAT out of the Revenue of the Colony there shall and may be issued and applied to defray the Supplementary charge for the Service of the Year ending on the 31st December, 1853, not already provided for, a sum not exceeding £1,500 6s 3d., in the manmer more particularly set forth and detailed under each head of expenditure respectively in the Schedule hereunder written.
- II. AND be it enacted, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay, from time to time, any sum or sums of money, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor shall, by any order or orders in writing, and signed by him, from time to time, direct; and the said Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such order accordingly; and the receipts of the persons towhom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.
