An Ordinance to explain and amend the 14th Vict., No 14, intituled "An Ordinance for Licensing Carts and Carriers."

Majesty Queen Victoria, an Ordinance was passed intituled
"An Ordinance for Licensing Carts and Carriers," wherein certain
expressions occur, the construction of which requires to be explained and enlarged as herein set forth;—Be it therefore enacted, "Agricultural" Produce
by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its to include pastoral and
Demendencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative

Council thereof, that, from and after the passing of this Ordinance the words "Agricultural Produce" in the said recited Ordinance, shall be deemed and taken to mean and include all produce of pastoral farms, as well as of tillage farms, and fish, game, and dairy produce.
