III. AND be it enacted, that the Treasurer of the said Colony shall issue and pay the said sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Treasurer to pay over Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order signed by ernor shall direct. him, shall from time to time order and direct, and that the payment so made, shall be charged upon, and payable out of the Revenue of the said Colony.

IV. AND be it enacted, that the said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and that the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid, shall be a full and valid discharge a sufficient discharge to to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum Treasurer. or sums of money as shall be therein mentioned, and that he shall and do receive credit for the same accordingly.
