An Ordinance for the appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty and to provide for the payment of certain unforeseen expenses during the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine.
WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for the service of the preamble. year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and also for the panyment
payment of certain unforeseen expenses of the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, for which no provision was made in the estimate of that year ;-Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that out

Supplementary charge for the year may be issued and applied to defray the supplementary charge for ending 31st Decem the service of the year ending on the thirty-first of December, one ber $1849, £ 1,5019 \mathrm{~s}$. thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and not provided for in the 11d. Ordinance of that year, a sum not exceeding one thousand five hundred and two pounds, nine shillings, and eleven pence, as detailed in the annexed Schedule No. 1.

For 1850, $£ 8,679 \mathrm{ls}$. II. AND be it enacted, that a sum not exceeding eight thousand 6d. six hundred and seventy-nine pounds, one shilling and sixpence, be charged upon the Revenue of the said colony for the service of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and applied in the manner following;--that is to say,

Civil Establishment. For the expenditure of the Civil Establishment, a sum not exceeding four thousand nine hundred and forty pounds, one shilling and sixpence;

Administration of For Administration of Justice, a sum not exceeding two hundred Justice. pounds;

Charitable Allowan- For Charitable Allowances a sum not exceeding one hundred ces. pounds;

Education. For Education, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding sixty pounds;

Hospitals. For Hospitals, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding one hundred and eighty-five pounds;

Police and Gaols. For Police and Gaols, exclusive of Establishments, a sum not exceeding seven hundred and thirty-seven pounds;

Rent of Offices. For Rent of Offices, a sum not exceeding thirty pounds.

For Transport and Travelling Expenses a sum not exceeding one Transport and Trahundred and twenty pounds; velling expenses.

For conveyance of Mails a sum not exceeding two hundred and Conveyance of mails fifty pounds;

For Roads, Streets and Bridges, a sum not exceeding seven hun- Roads, Streets, and dred and fifty pounds;

For Miscellaneous Services, a sum not exceeding sixty-five pounds; Miscellaneous Servi-
For interest on Debentures, a sum not exceeding ninety pounds; Interest on Debentures.
For Aboriginals, a sum nót exceeding three hundred and twenty- Aborigines. eight pounds;

AND be it enacted, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue Treasurer to pay sums and pay from time to time any sum or sums of money for the pur- specfied as Governor poses hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums mayiorder, respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing signed by him, from time to time direct, and the said Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all And to be allowed sums

sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly, and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly,
