An Ordinance to amend an Act entitled "an Act to provide for the Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages, in the Colony of Western Australia."

HEREAS an Act was passed in the fourth and fifth years of Preamble. the reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "an Act to provide for the Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in the colony of the & 5th Vict. No. 9 to Western Australia;" and whereas it is expedient to amend the same

in certain respects; -Be it therefore enacted, by his Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that some Parties to give informa. person present at the death, or in attendence during the last illness, tion to Registrar. of every person during or the committee during the last illness, or tenement, or the master of any coasting vessel or boat, in which such death shall have happened, or such other person as the Registrar shall deem most competent according to the circumstances, shall give information upon being requested so to do to the Registrar, according to the best of his or her knowledge or belief, of the several particulars required to be known touching the death of such deceased person; and that any such person refusing to give such information, or giving false information, shall be liable to the like pains and penalties as are provided by the said Act for neglecting to give notice of a death, or for wilfully making any false statement respectively, and that every pecuniary penalty under this Ordinance shall be recovered and appropriated in like manner as the like penalties under the said Act are thereby directed to be recovered and appropriated.

II. AND be it enacted, that all such entries of deaths as shall have been made by the respective Registrars since passing of the said Act, upon other information than that required under the said Act, where they were unable to obtain the requisite information from the parties in the said Act mentioned, shall be valid for the purposes of the said Act.

Form of registration to be as in schedules.

III. AND be it enacted, that all births, deaths, and marriages shall be registered henceforth according to the forms in the Schedules hereunto annexed.

IV. AND be it enacted, that the said Act, as to all proceedings, Terms Registrar and Sub- matters and things henceforth to be taken or done thereunder, shall Registrar to be construed be read and construed as if the words "Registrar-General had been substituted in and throughout the same for the word "Registrar," and as if the word "Registrar" had been substituted in and throughout the same for the words "Sub-Registrar."
