An Ordinance to make perpetual an Act entitled "an Act to facilitate actions against Persons absent from the Colony, and against Persons sued as Joint Contractors.

HEREAS an Act was passed in the sixth year of the reign of 6th Vict. No. 4. make Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to facilitate actions against persons absent from the colony, and against persons sued in

Joint Contractors," which said Act is about to expire: and whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be continued;—Be it therefore enacted, by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, that the said Act shall be and the same is hereby made perpetual.
