An Act to continue for a limited time "An Act to enable the Inhabitants of any Township to assess themselves for the Improvement of the Town."

WHEREAS in the second year of the reign of Her present Preamble. Majesty Queen Victoria, an Act was passed entituled "An Act₂ victoria 5. to enable the Inhabitants of any Township to assess themselves for the improvement of the Town;" And, whereas, it is expedient that the said Act should be continued for a limited period; Be it therefore Act continued until 1st Ocenacted, that the said Act shall be, and the same is continued in force tober, 1841. until the first day of October next.
